Hey there, my name's Doug. I'm a graphic designer, and my two favourite things in life are ideas and skateboarding.

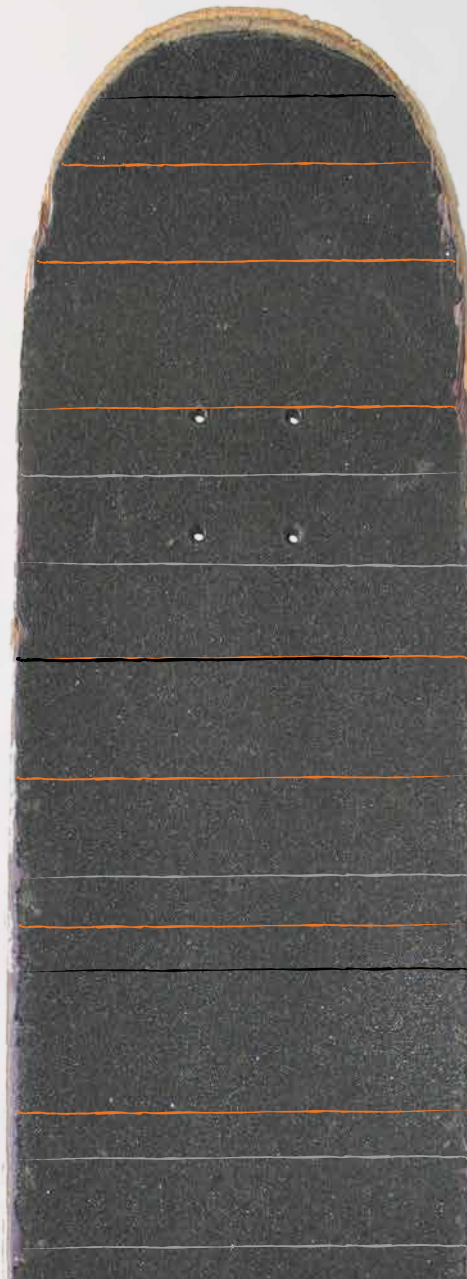
